
# Youth International Economic Forum 2010

#### Forum PARTICIPANTS

Businesspeople, government employees, undergraduates, graduate students, thought leaders and people from the public sector (non-governmental organizations and companies) between the ages of 18 and 30 from all over the world will be selected by an independent jury based on their accomplishments, experience and life goals.

#### Participation criteria

- 1.1 Age: 18-30 years old.
- 1.2 English language proficiency (no less than intermediate)
- **1.3** International experience: work and study abroad, joint international partnership projects.
- **1.4** Achievements: experience in carrying out projects affecting the business community or social sphere or scientific, cultural or public achievements
- 1.5 Personal positioning: available resume, and/or social network references; an essay answering the following questions: "How am I developing myself?", "How do I develop others?", "How do I develop society?"

## Participation conditions

- 4.1 Participation in the Forum shall be exclusively by written invitation by the YIEF Organizing Committee.
- 4.2 Applications may be submitted to the Organizing Committee from April 19 till May 21, 2010, by following the registration procedure set out on the YIEF website (http://en.mmef.ru/) in the Taking Part section, and completing all of the required fields in the online application form.
- 4.3 Applications will be reviewed by the Organizing Committee in accordance with the YIEF Candidate Selection Criteria, and successful candidates will be notified in writing before May 30, 2010.
- 4.4 The Organizing Committee may reject any application without further explanation.
- 4.5 Successful applicants must accept or decline their invitation to participate by email no later than May 31, 2010.

Applications to participate in the Forum may be submitted from April 19 to May 5, 2010.
